QUESTIONS ABOUT HOMELESS BIRD Part 1

This is about a thirteen year old Indian girl (Koly) whose parents find her a husband because they can't afford to feed her. The story follows Koly's life until she reaches adulthood. Words unfamiliar to Americans are found in a glossary at the end.

The questions below start at the beginning and end after the first section of Chapter Seven.

Chapter One

- 1. What is a dowry? Are dowries a custom in your country?
- 2. How does Koly's father earn a living? How does her mother?
- 3. Koly's parents can't afford school for her. What is that money needed for?
- 4. What does Koly's mother make for the wedding? What does Koly make?
- 5. The bridegroom's family demands money for the dowry. What do her parents do?
- 6. What valuable item from her own dowry does her mother contribute?
- 7. List the things Koly takes with her when she leaves for her wedding.
- 8. What signs are there that this wedding match might be a mistake? Why does the family go through with it anyway?
- 9. Describe how Koly is prepared for the wedding.
- 10. Read the words quoted from the wedding ceremony. Discuss them.
- 11. Describe the bridegroom.
- 12. What does Koly do with her earrings?
- 13. Where does Koly sleep on her wedding night?

Chapter Two

- 14. Koly is forbidden to visit her new husband Hari, but she does anyway. Describe this visit. How does Sass (her mother-in-law) react when she discovers them together?
- 15. What does Koly's sister-in-law Chandra tell her the family wants from the marriage?
- 16. Hari is examined by a physician. What is his sickness? How long will he live?

Chapter Three

- 17. What is the purpose of the visit to Varanasi? Why is Koly allowed to go?
- 18. Describe what Koly sees at the Ganges River. What rite does the family perform with Hari? Does Hari like the water?
- 19. What happens to Hari the night after the Ganges visit?
- 20. Hari is cremated and his ashes scattered on the Ganges. Read the funeral chant included near the end of Chapter Three. Discuss it.

Chapter Four

- 21. What is Koly told to wear to the government office? What does Sass say the forms they obtain are for? Is she telling the truth?
- 22. What impact do Sass's scoldings have on Koly?
- 23. Why does Sassur (her father-in-law) teach her to read?
- 24. Where does she practice reading? Why there?
- 25. Does Sass think women need to read? Explain.

Chapter Five

- 26. Koly wonders whether Chandra's bridegroom will be good to her. What does Chandra say? Do you believe her answer is right?
- 27. What is Sass keeping for herself? What does Koly try to do? What happens?
- 28. Why does Sass demand Koly's earrings? What is Sass's reaction when she refuses?
- 29. Koly embroiders a quilt for Chandra's wedding. What events does she sew into it?
- 30. Describe Chandra's new husband.

Chapter Six

- 31. When Sass refuses to be her friend, whom does Koly befriend?
- 32. What does the government official tell Koly she must do to get her widow's pension?
- 33. What happens to Sassur the day he comes home early?

Chapter Seven

- 34. Describe Sassur's funeral.
- 35. Describe Chandra after a year of marriage.
- 36. What does Koly trade for Sassur's book of poems?
