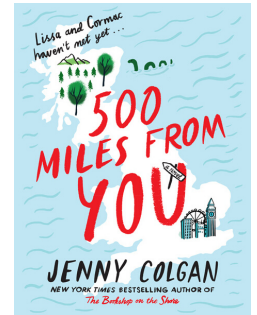


### LEARN TO READ WITH MY FIRST BOOK CLUB

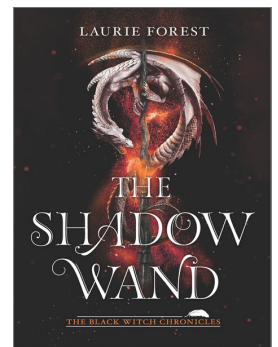
**Wednesday, June 17th

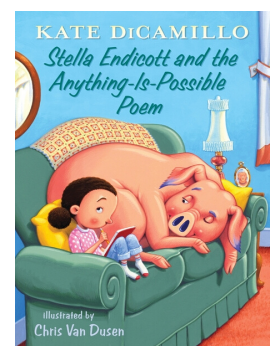

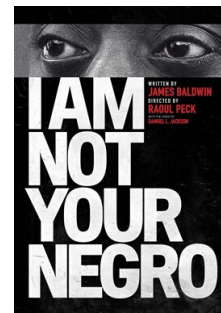

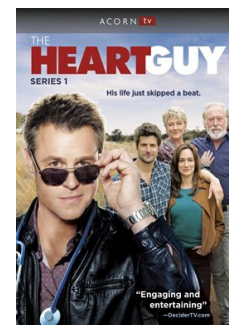
