Curbside Service Now Available!

Central Park Library's Curbside Pickup process is currently underway! Stay safe and get your Library materials in a socially distant fashion, with grab-and-go service.

For Returns : Items must be returned through the Library Bookdrop Park on the East side of the Library. Be sure to wear your mask and keep 6ft away from other people.

Curbside Pickup Process: Place a hold through the Library Catalog. You will receive a notification when your items are Ready for Pickup. When you arrive at the Library, park your vehicle in the designated pickup area and call 408-615-2993. We will also have a Walk-Up Area for pick-up. Library staff will be outside to assist you with any issues!

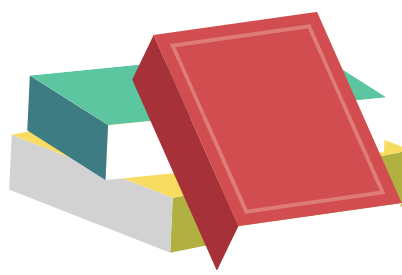
YOUR FAVORITE (ONLINE) TRIVIA

4 PM**

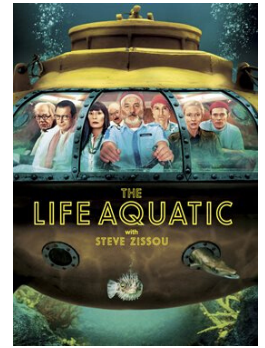

ESL BOOK CLUB

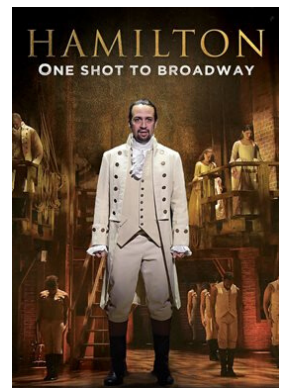
