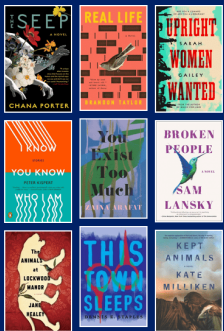


MANAGING DEBT
