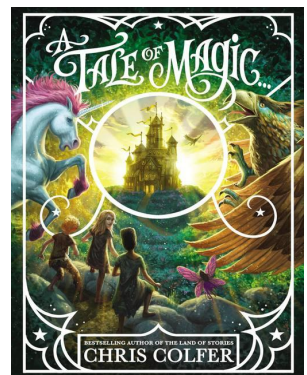

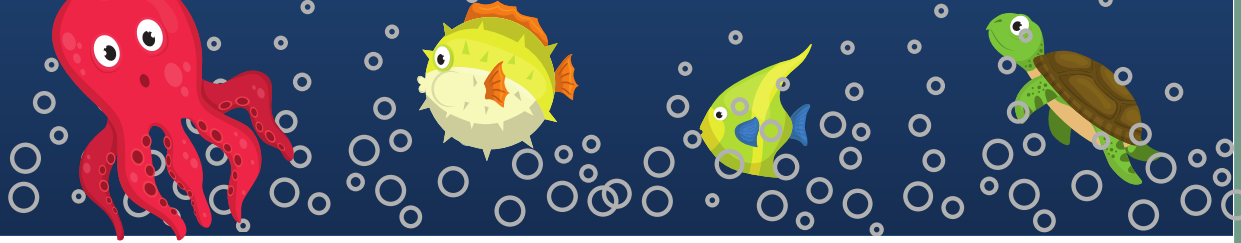

Soak up the sun and sing & dance to some fun summer tunes with a fun summer & ocean themed storytime!

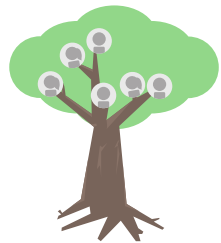


# LEARNING POD RESOURCES FOR PRESCHOOL - 5TH GRADE (FOR ADULTS ONLY)

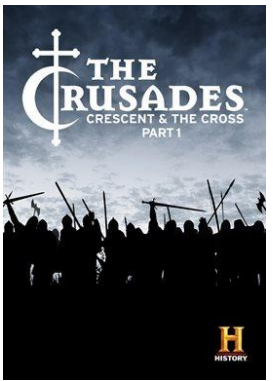

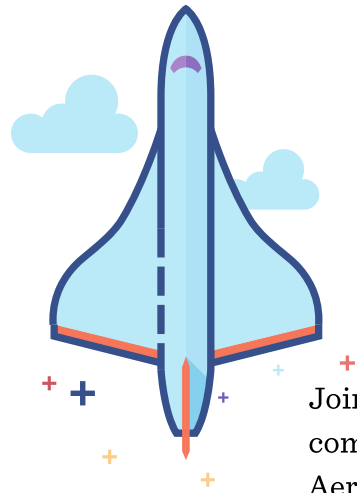
