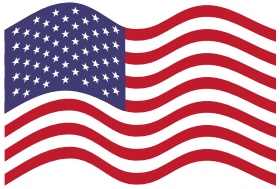

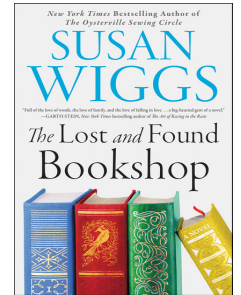
FALL INTO READING BOOKSHARE

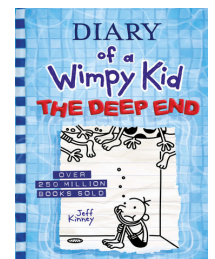

KINDNESS STRENGTHENED RELATIONSHIPS



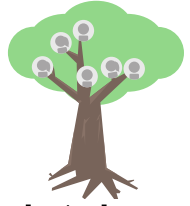
