### GINGERBREAD CHARACTER CONTEST

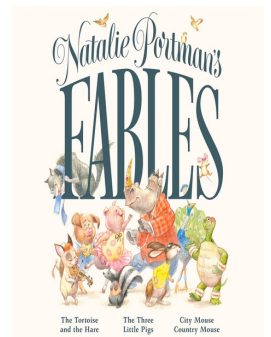
**Nov. 20 - Dec. 7**

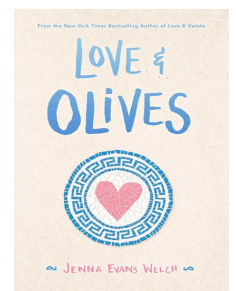

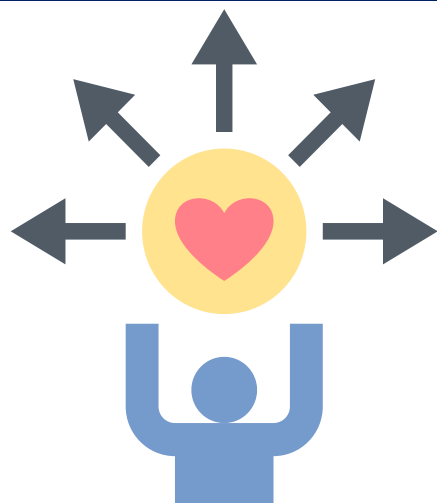
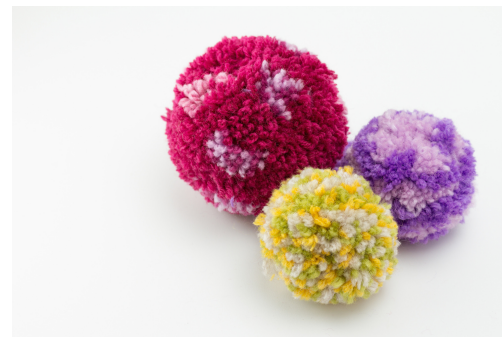
