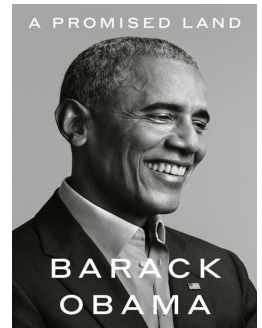

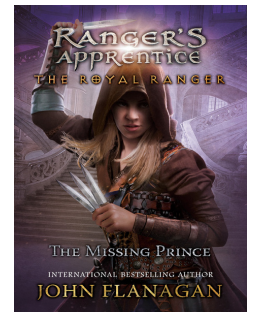

- Preventive healthcare strategies to maximize health as we age

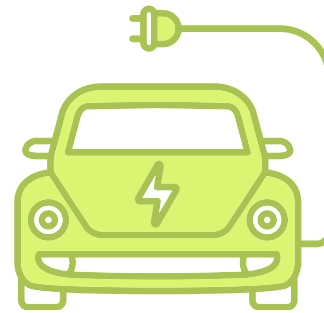

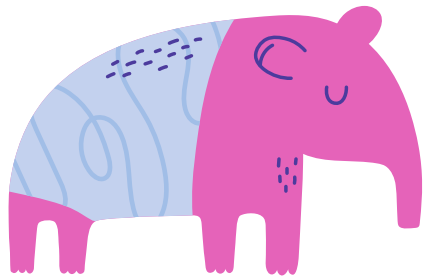
Geek out at the Santa Clara City Library!
