Vocabulary to Practice

- **Wish:** Noun - A desire or longing for something that is not currently present or happening. Example: "My wish is to travel around the world."
- **Dream:** Noun - A cherished aspiration or hope for the future. Example: "Her dream is to become a famous singer."
- **Hope:** Noun - A feeling of expectation and desire for a particular thing to happen. Example: "I hope to pass my exams with good grades."
- **Desire:** Noun - A strong feeling of wanting or wishing for something. Example: "His desire to succeed motivates him to work hard."
- **Longing:** Noun - A deep and intense yearning or desire for something or someone. Example: "She felt a longing to see her family after being away for so long."
- **Goal:** Noun - An aim or objective that one is trying to achieve. Example: "His goal is to run a marathon next year."
- **Ambition:** Noun - A strong desire to achieve something or to be successful. Example: "Her ambition is to become a successful businesswoman."
- **Aspire:** Verb - To have a strong desire or ambition to achieve something. Example: "She aspires to become a famous writer someday."
- **Yearn:** Verb - To have a strong and persistent longing or desire for something. Example: "He yearns for a peaceful and happy life."
- **Crave:** Verb - To have an intense desire for something. Example: "She craves chocolate whenever she's stressed."
- **Envision:** Verb - To imagine or picture in one's mind; to have a mental image of something desired. Example: "He envisions a world without poverty."
- **Seek:** Verb - To actively look for or try to obtain something desired. Example: "She seeks happiness in simple things."
