- Sibling (noun) a brother or sister.
- Parents (noun) a father or mother.
- Grandparents (noun) the parents of a person's father or mother.
- Child (noun) a young human being who is not yet an adult.
- Son (noun) a male child or person in relation to his parents.
- Daughter (noun) a female child or person in relation to her parents.
- Brother (noun) a male with the same parents as someone else.
- Sister (noun) a female with the same parents as someone else.
- Aunt (noun) the sister of someone's father or mother or the wife of someone's uncle.
- Uncle (noun) the brother of someone's mother or father or the husband of someone's aunt.
- Cousin (noun) a child of a person's aunt or uncle, or, more generally, a distant relative.
- Nephew (noun) a son of your brother or sister, or a son of your husband's or wife's brother or sister.
- Niece (noun) a daughter of your brother or sister, or a daughter of your husband's or wife's brother or sister.
- In-laws (noun) the parents, brothers, sisters, etc. of your husband or wife.
- Grandchild (noun) the child of your son or daughter.
- Family tree (noun) a diagram that shows all the people in a family over many generations and their relationship to each other.
- Married (adjective) having a husband or a wife.
- Single (adjective) not married, or not having a romantic relationship with someone.
- Relative (noun) a member of your family.
