- 5. The crop failure caused major starvation in Malawi. Who should be responsible for preventing starvation when crops fail? Why do you think this family survived while others died?
- 6. Discovering the library was eye-opening for William. Describe your earliest memories of visiting a library.

7.	The village people called William a madman while he was building his windmill. Why do people tease and call names when a person pursues an innovative idea? Has it happened to you?
