- Is there a quirky habit or uncommon belief you hold dear, even if others find it strange?
- Who is your unlikely role model, someone who inspires you in a surprising way?
- If you could meet your future self, what would you want to know about how your unique qualities have shaped your life?
- Have you ever had a life experience that made you aware of your uniqueness?
- What qualities do you admire in others that are different from your own?
- Share a funny anecdote or story that perfectly captures your unique personality and sense of humor.

- **fluently:** (adverb) Speaking a language effortlessly and smoothly, without having to stop and think about grammar or vocabulary.
- **time capsule:** (noun) A container filled with objects and information about a particular time period, buried or stored to be opened in the future.
- **laugh out loud:** (verb phrase) To laugh uncontrollably and openly, expressing genuine amusement or joy.
- **sets you apart:** (verb phrase) Makes you different from others in a special or noticeable way, highlighting your unique qualities.
- **self-portrait:** (noun) A painting or drawing of yourself, representing your appearance and personality.
- **global issue:** (noun phrase) A problem that affects people all over the world, like climate change, poverty, or inequality.
- **sparks your passion:** (verb phrase) Ignites your enthusiasm and strong interest in something, motivating you to learn more or take action.
- **quirky:** (adjective) Unusual or strange in a charming or interesting way, not following typical norms.
- **role model:** (noun) Someone you admire and look up to, whose behavior and achievements inspire you to be your best self.
- **future self:** (noun phrase) The person you will become in the years to come, a hypothetical version of yourself based on your current path and choices.
- **anecdote:** (noun) A short, personal story or incident that illustrates a point or reveals something interesting about someone or something.
