Vocabulary to Practice

- hanging out with friends: (verb phrase) Spending time with friends in a relaxed and enjoyable way, often doing activities together.
- perfect party: (noun phrase) A party that meets all your desires and expectations, perfectly fulfilling what you imagine a great party to be.
- dream guests: (noun phrase) People you would love to have as guests at a party, often celebrities or famous individuals you admire.
- party mood: (noun phrase) A feeling of excitement, joy, and enthusiasm that makes you want to celebrate and have fun at a party.
- get the party going: (verb phrase) To create a lively and exciting atmosphere at a party, making people dance, socialize, and have a good time. (This can involve playing music, starting activities, or simply being enthusiastic.)
